





The Global Exhibition Market – KPI's





Europe and North America make up more than 70% of the global market







The European exhibition market is dominated by 5 countries
















Belgium ranks 15th for number of meetings in 2018, 12 countries out of the TOP 20 are European






Brussels and Flanders make up 95% of the Belgian market in 2018, Brussels' share has been stable over the past 10 years






Medicine is the most frequent sector in Belgium, the sector distribution is in line with the global one








Brussels ranks 17th for number of meetings, 8 of the TOP 20 cities are in a radius of 1,000 km from Brussels









UIA events in Brussels by venues – all events, 2018




UIA events in Brussels by venues – events with >500 participants, 2018




